# Dear Keuring participant:

Welcome to our KWPN-NA Keuring, held on Wednesday, August 29, 2018. We are excited to be hosting this event, and look forward to meeting everyone and their wonderful Dutch Horses! Please feel free to invite friends and family to attend the Keuring, the KWPN has a strong focus on education, and welcomes all spectators. Enclosed in this mailing you will find a schedule, directions, hotel & general Information and a stall reservation form.

Please make note of where and when your classes are and keep up with the ringing order, as not to miss your turn.

### **HEALTH REQUIREMENTS -**

Negative coggins for the current year. Foals at the Dam's side will use their Dam's coggins test. (ET Foals use the birth mother's coggins). Out of state horses need a Health Certificate within 30 days of Keuring. Please enclose your current year coggins for all horses with your Stabling Request form.

Please do not bring sick horses to our Keuring! If your horse is showing any signs of illness or fever within 5 days of the keuring date, please leave them home!

### **STABLING** -

Stalls are permanent, smallest dimensions are 10 x 12, and are \$65 per horse or mare/foal combo. They will be clearly marked with Owner & Horse's names for your arrival. 1 bag of bedding is provided for you, additional may be purchased for \$6. You may bring additional shavings if you wish. No Straw, please. Stabling requests must be received with payment in full, stalls are on a First Come, First served. There are no refunds on stabling.

Please bring your own water buckets & feed pans. Please dispose of manure and soiled bedding in the appropriate places. There is a \$15 refund if you strip your own stall before departing. Haul Ins are allowed with pre-approval. The fee is \$35.

### ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE TIMES - Late or Early arrivals may be accommodated by special request.

Tuesday 8/28/2018 – Horses may arrive from 3-9PM

Wednesday 8/29/2015 – Horses must depart the facility by 6PM (unless Keuring runs late)

Any other requests may be accommodated on a case by case basis. Please inquire.

# WARM UP/ SCHOOLING/ TURNOUT - Protective headgear must be worn while mounted.

There will be a schooling area provided for the riding test participants, location and footing TBD (footing may be grass). Turn Out areas are limited, but may be available; please inquire.

<u>HANDLERS</u> – Brendan Curtis, fee is \$ 75 per horse **Cash only please**. Please indicate on the stabling form if you need a handler. **If you are presenting a foal, be prepared to have handlers for your mare & foal for the final walk ring.** 

BRAIDER - Fee is \$ TBD per horse. Cash only please. Please indicate on your stabling form if you need your horse(s) braided.

**PHOTOGRAPHER** - Sean Reilly, of Sean Reilly Photography, https://www.facebook.com/SeanReillyPhotography/
Only the official show photographer will be allowed in the arena, all others may shoot from the viewing areas around the arena.
Please contact the Photographer about private sessions for your horses, these need to be booked in advance so enough time is budgeted! This is the perfect time to get great shots of your horses.

I have arranged for a special event rate, so please be sure to indicate on your stabling request form if you want your horses photographed.

**DOGS** – Please leave your pets at home or in your hotel.

**CHILDREN** – Must be under **ADULT** supervision at all times.

**PARKING** – Please park your vehicles & trailers in the appropriate location. This will be indicated.

**FOOD** <u>—</u> Light refreshments will be available, and Lunch will also be available on a pre-order/ pay basis for \$10 per person. Please indicate on your stabling form how many for lunch, and if you need a vegetarian option or special diet request.

**EVALUATION OF 3YR OLD AND OLDER HORSES** – Horses will be presented individually. They will be measured, have their mouths checked, be shown on the hard surface and the linear score sheet will be completed. After each group is done with measurement/hard surface, the horses will proceed individually to the Outdoor arena for the free movement and/or jumping (if applicable). Evaluations and ribbons will be done at the end of each group. Branding will be done at the jury's discretion, in the Round Pen Area.

**MEASUREMENTS & HARD SURFACE** — Will take place in the front of the barn and on the West side of the Driveway. Please be ready for the Jury when called.

<u>SCORE SHEETS</u> – Horses 3 and older will receive a written evaluation, (Linear Score Sheet) after they are judged. There are no written sheets for horses under 3 yrs of age.

**BRANDING** — Mares and Geldings three years old and older that are accepted into the Main Studbook with a First or Second Premium may be branded if the owner desires. Horses must wear their bridle numbers for branding. Branding will be done outside on the South East side of the barn, Time TBD.

RIDING CLASSES AND IBOP - N/A

**EVALUATING FOALS, YEARLINGS & TWO YEAR OLD FILLIES AND GELDINGS** - The young horses will be evaluated in the Outdoor Arena. The round pen may be used as a holding area, please be at the arena early, as not to miss your turn!

**ATTIRE** – As outlined in the Keuring Information brochure, anyone entering the arena as a handler or helper should be dressed in whites.

Please note that the schedule provided is a guideline, and time of go can be moved up or back depending on scratches. Please be sure you are here at least 2 hours before you are scheduled to present your horse.

# DIRECTIONS TO THE FARM- Bear to the Left once you enter the driveway and circle around to unload

#### From the Richmond Area:

Take I-95 South

Take exit 48A for Wagner Rd E, Merge onto Wagner Rd

Turn right onto US-460 E/County Dr

Continue on US-460 E for about 51 Miles

Turn right to merge onto US-13 S/US-58 W toward Emporia

Take the right exit to continue on US-13 S, follow signs for Ahoskie NC/Edenton NC

Exit the highway toward US-13/32 South Ahoskie NC, Turn right onto Carolina Rd(Route 32)

Continue past the Suffolk Airport, and make a Left turn to stay on Carolina Road / US-32 Southbound for 8 miles.

Take a left onto Deer Forest Road, the farm is about 1 Mile down on the South side of the road.

### From Norfolk International Airport/ Chesapeake / Virginia Beach

Get on I-64 E (Toward Chesapeake/ Virginia Beach) from Norview Ave

Follow I-64 E, I-264 W and US-13 S to Suffolk

Use the right 2 lanes to take exit 284A to merge onto I-264 W toward Norfolk

Keep right to stay on I-264 W

Keep left at the fork to stay on I-264 W, follow signs for Interstate 264 W/Downtown Tunnel/Portsmouth

Use the right 2 lanes to take exit 1 for Interstate 664/I-664 toward U.S. 13/U.S. 58/U.S. 460/Bowers Hill/Suffolk/Richmond

Use the right 3 lanes to take exit 13A-13B to merge onto US-13 S/US-58 W toward US-460 W/Suffolk

Take the right exit to continue on US-13 S, follow signs for Ahoskie NC/Edenton NC

Exit the highway toward US-13/32 South Ahoskie NC/ Edenton NC

Turn right onto Carolina Rd (Route 32)

Continue past the Suffolk Airport, and make a Left turn to stay on Carolina Road / US-32 Southbound for 8 miles.

Take a left onto Deer Forest Road, the farm is about 1 Mile down on the South side of the road.

### From Hampton/Newport News: Depending upon Traffic!

Take either I 664 South using the Monitor- Merrimac Bridge Tunnel

Take exit 13A to merge onto US-13 S/US-58 W toward US-460 W/Suffolk

Take the right exit to continue on US-13 S, follow signs for Ahoskie NC/Edenton NC

Exit the highway toward US-13/32 South Ahoskie NC/ Edenton NC

Turn right onto Carolina Rd (Route 32)

Continue past the Suffolk Airport, and make a Left turn to stay on Carolina Road / US-32 Southbound for 8 miles.

Take a left onto Deer Forest Road, the farm is about 1 Mile down on the South side of the road.

Bear to the Left once you enter the driveway and circle around to unload.

OR the James River Bridge

Use US-258 S/W Mercury Blvd toward James River Bridge

Turn right to stay on US-258 S

Turn left onto Benns Grant Blvd

Use the left 2 lanes to turn left onto VA-10 E/VA-32 S

Continue straight to stay on VA-10 E/VA-32 S

Keep left to continue on Godwin Blvd

Take the Right exit to merge onto US-13 S/US-460 W/US-58 W toward Petersburg/Emporia

Take the right exit to continue on US-13 S, follow signs for Ahoskie NC/Edenton NC

Exit the highway toward US-13/32 South Ahoskie NC/ Edenton NC

Turn right onto Carolina Rd (Route 32)

Continue past the Suffolk Airport, and make a Left turn to stay on Carolina Road / US-32 Southbound for 8 miles.

Take a left onto Deer Forest Road, the farm is about 1 Mile down on the South side of the road.

### From the South:

Take I-95 North

Take exit 11A to merge onto US-58 E toward Norfolk for about 55 Miles

Turn right to merge onto US-13 S toward VA-32/Ahoskie North Carolina/Edenton Carolina

Exit the highway toward US-13/32 South Ahoskie NC/ Edenton NC

Turn right onto Carolina Rd (Route 32)

Continue past the Suffolk Airport, and make a Left turn to stay on Carolina Road / US-32 Southbound for 8 miles.

Take a left onto Deer Forest Road, the farm is about 1 Mile down on the South side of the road.

# From the Holiday Inn/Hampton Inn on Centerbrooke Ln, Suffolk:

Take a right on Centerbrooke Ln.

Take a right on Godwin Blvd.

Take the Right exit to merge onto US-13 S/US-460 W/US-58 W toward Petersburg/Emporia

Take the right exit to continue on US-13 S, follow signs for Ahoskie NC/Edenton NC

Exit the highway toward US-13/32 South Ahoskie NC/ Edenton NC

Turn right onto Carolina Rd (Route 32)

Continue past the Suffolk Airport, and make a Left turn to stay on Carolina Road / US-32 Southbound for 8 miles.

Take a left onto Deer Forest Road, the farm is about 1 Mile down on the South side of the road.
